

## **Boating Regulations on Lake LaSalle/Use of the Lake**

**Due to the extreme shoreline erosion, please lower your boating speed when boating near the shoreline.**

*Please remind those on the water of any infractions.*

- 1. All watercraft on the lake MUST be owned by a property owner/LLPOA member**
- 2. All watercraft (boats, pontoons, kayaks, canoes, pedal boats, etc.) MUST bear a Lake LaSalle sticker on the starboard side.**
- 3. The maximum watercraft motor size is 40 hp for voting members.**
- 4. Non-voting members' motors cannot exceed 10 hp.**
- 5. Non-voting members cannot launch a pontoon on Lake LaSalle**
- 6. Boat traffic is to travel in a counter-clockwise direction around the lake.**
- 7. "No-wake zones" are labeled with a yellow buoy/s.**
- 8. The entire Lake is considered a "no-wake zone" between 7 pm and 9 am.**
- 9. Motorized boats will grant the right-of-way to non-motorized boats.**
- 10. Idle speed is required in "no-wake zones."**
- 11. Motorized boat racing is prohibited.**
- 12. There is NO fishing or swimming off the dam.**
